

Eurail Italy - Spain Pass

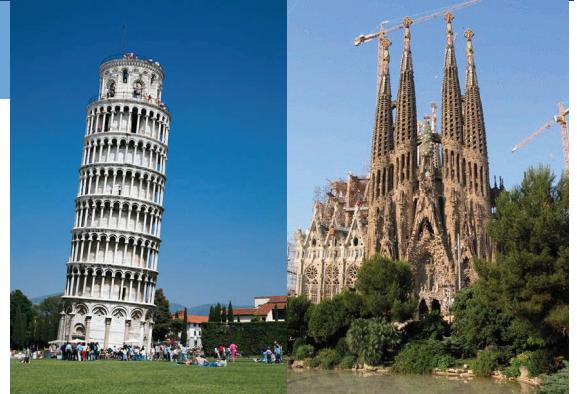
Unlimited rail travel in Italy and Spain. Available in Adult and Save in 1st and 2nd class and 2nd class for Youth

Benefits and Features

- * Unlimited travel on the national rail networks of Italy and Spain
- * 1st & 2nd class
- * Validity: any 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, or 10 days within a 2- month period
- * Travel days may be used consecutively or nonconsecutively

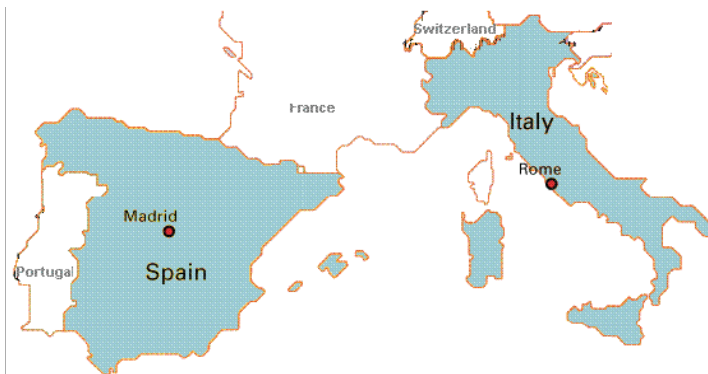
Options

- * Saverpass for 2 or more traveling together
- * Youth pass in 2nd class only, for travelers under 26 on their first day of travel



Child Policy

- * Discounted fare for children 4 - 11 years
- * Children under 4 free when sharing an adult passenger's accommodations



Bonuses

- Free ferry crossings from Villa S. Giovanni to Messina (Sicily) operated by Trenitalia (standard class)
- 20% reduction on the standard passenger fares and cabin fares on crossings operated by Grimaldi Ferries on the following routes: Civitavecchia to Barcelona (Spain) and Salerno to Valencia (Spain)

Refund Policy

- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated
- A 15% cancellation penalty applies to unused passes returned within 1 year of issue date
- Non refundable if lost or stolen except as covered by Rail Protection Plan
- Lost or stolen passes may be protected with the purchase of a Rail Protection Plan



Conditions of use

1. Residents of Europe, the Russian Federation or Turkey are not eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Italy - Spain Pass.
2. Passes must be validated within 6 months of issuing date by a railway official in Italy and Spain (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number
3. Passes must be validated within 6 months of issue date by a railway official in Italy or Spain (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number.
4. All parties must be present when validating a Saverpass
5. Passes must be validated prior to boarding first train or using a bonus
6. The date of travel has to be entered before boarding the first train/bonus, by the traveler, in the corresponding box of the calendar
7. Person's using a U.S. Military I.D. is eligible to use this pass.
8. 7:00pm rule: if an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated Eurail Italy - Spain Pass, the passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass
